INTRODUCTION

COMRADE is one of the leading clubs in IIUM that focus on the development of Orang Asli. We would like to propose a programme called Little Caliph Project which is a long term goal project providing tuition for the Orang Asli Kids at Kg. Teji, Kg Abu and Kg Senagkar Pahang and focuses on the basic subjects, which is Mathematic, Bahasa Melayu, English, Science and Pendidikan Islam.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- To phase up the level of education of the Asli students and to heighten their awareness about the importance of knowledge.
- To develop self-potential and leadership skills of Asli students for the betterment of their lives as well as to assist them to achieve life goals.
- To boost up their self-confidence and self-esteem and to incorporate the Islamic way of life among students.
- To brings the society's attention to Orang Asli existence as part of the society.
- To expose the parents to their children future perspective since they are the biggest influencer in the student's life.
- To increase parents' concern towards their children studies

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ACTIVITIES AND TASKS

- **Tuition Class and Mentoring Series**

Since it is very hard for the Asli students to get education assistance outside of their classroom, we would like to conduct several series of tuition class for about every weekend in the Asli village. We have chosen Kg Teji, Abu, Senangkar and Susu to conduct the tuition class for the Asli children since we have made a mini library in the village. Perhaps later in the future we could do the same in other different villages. This tuition class is aimed to mentor and assist the children in their study. Among major subjects to be taught are English, Mathematics and Science.

- i. **Classes implementation**

A one-hour class for each subject will be conducted for 2 days of each phase. The tuition will be done at the same time at 3 different villages. Thus, the volunteers will be divided into three teams and go to 3 villages to conduct the tuition classes. There will be at least 3 teachers/mentors for each village. In each village, the students will be divided into 3 levels; level 1, level 2, level 3 according to their respective ages.

e.g Maths level 1, Maths level 2, Maths level 3.

English level 1, English level 2, English level 3

- ii. **Subjects**

- English
- Mathematics
- Science
- Bahasa Melayu
- Pendidikan Islam

(The subjects will be teach based on the government school's syllabus. The questions, quizzes, and/or exercises will be given to enhance the students' learning.)

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iii. **Sustainability plan**

Since this is a Little Caliph Project 2.0 which means the second project that we want to propose as continuity from the first project that we conducted on April and May. Thus, we would like to continue this project until the end of this year. Even though, we only have 4 phases of the project, the tuition class will still be continued without the volunteers, however the teachers that have been selected among the villagers will continue the tuition class. Among that period, there will be volunteers from us to come and observed the tuition class. Each kids must have they own personal performance book in order for us to evaluate they progressiveness.

- **Motivational Modules**

In this programme, we will provide several modules or activities for the children in which each of the modules will try to achieve the objectives of this programme. The modules include dynamic group activities, motivational games and so on. The modules will be interactive and suitable for their respective ages.

- **Teaching training courses**

In this programme, we wanted to select several young adults or drop out school teenagers and train them to be a trainer/teacher for the tuition class series that we planned to do. This could be a stepping stone for them or another career opportunity especially for those who had not finished their school because of unavoidable circumstances. Besides that, there are also teenagers and young adults who get married early and this could help them to have a job/activity instead of just staying at home at their early ages and help the kids in their village. Several workshop or training need to be done for them to ensure they are ready for the task. When they have started teaching for the tuition class, we would like to propose for some 'elaun' or pocket money for the work that they have done depending on the budget or sponsors that we get.

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- *Ziarah* & Follow up

Students are divided into few groups that contain three or four students and they will be given to the foster families but they do not stay together. Students stay at the places that have been provided. Then, they will visit or *ziarah* their family frequently during this programme. During *ziarah*, they will create a good environment by exchange background information known as *taaruf*. Moreover, the foster children will distribute the ration during the *ziarah*. This *ziarah* is very important because during the *ziarah*, we can encourage the parents to be supportive in their children's studies. This will be efficient to convince the parents on their children's education.

- Mentor-mentee follow-up programme

We hope that our relationship with the students will be long lasting and we hope that we still able to mentor the students despite physical distance. This mentor-mentee follow-up programme is a programme in which 2-3 students will be grouped under a mentor who will try to assist the Asli students and give moral support to them even after this programme. Thus, we can track the students' achievement from time to time.

- Eradicate poverty among Orang Asli communities (Vision 2020).
- Develop and empower Asli youths involvement to contributes for their community.
- Strengthen IIUM's student bonds with the Asli community.
- Asli community can acquire new information, knowledge and experience for the development while IIUM students gain skills and invaluable experience from this project.
- Asli students and IIUM students both will be more motivated in their study and realizing their dreams.
- Parents will be more supportive towards their children's future choices.

EXPECTED PROJECT RESULTS

- To ensure the improvement of Asli students' in their performance and have a short-term and long-term goals in their study.
- Able to provide a comfortable place for their education and sport activities.
- To encourage the Asli children to have ambitions and visions in their lives.
- To make sure that all IIUM students are able to implement what they have envisioned and learn some lessons, experience and knowledge.
- To make them ready mentally, spiritually, physically, in facing the challenging world.
