EXPECTED PROJECT RESULTS

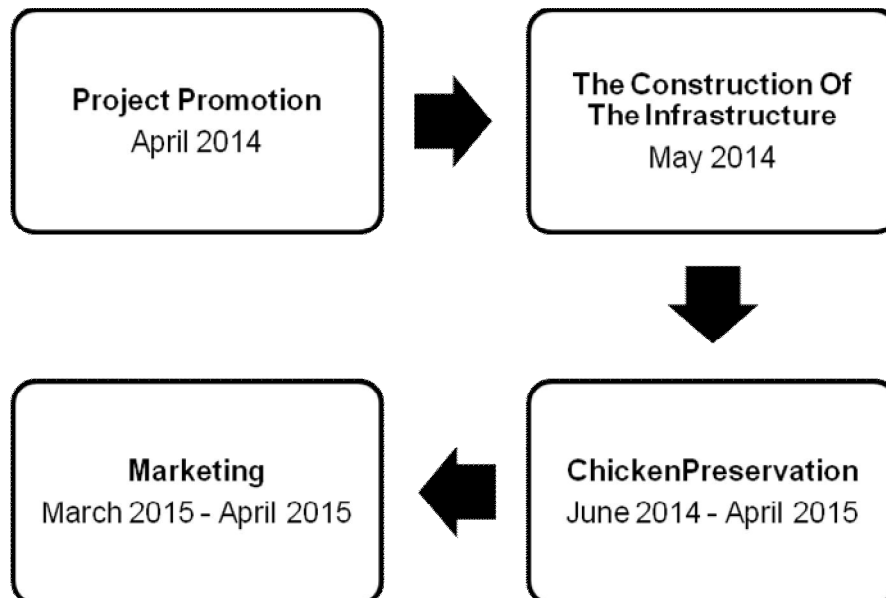
1. The villagers felt this Integration project will support and increase their socioeconomic.
